

Welcome to Nolla!

Nolla's ideology is based on promoting nature and short-distance tourism as a means to achieve carbon neutrality. How can I get into the Nolla cabin?

You will receive a door code via email before you arrive at the cabin. Enter the code in the smart lock preceded and followed by an asterisk (lower left corner) and the lock will open. If you type in the wrong code five times, the door will lock for 10 minutes, after which you can re-enter the code.

How does the stove work?

1. Start by pressing the start button (round, right corner) for about 2 seconds.
Give it about 2 minutes to switch on.
2. The stove will start automatically in the cooking mode (keep the lid open). You can adjust the heat level with the adjusting knob on the left side. If you want the stove to be in heating mode, turn the adjusting knob back and forth 2–3 times between the numbers 1–6.
3. A small light will switch on in the lower left corner when the stove is in heating mode.
Close the lid. You can adjust the temperature with the adjusting knob.
4. Switch the stove off by pressing the start button for 2–3 seconds.
The stove will stay on for about 5 minutes after you have switched it off.
5. The stove is safe and originally designed for boats. Exhaust gases are directed out of the cabin. We only use fuel made from renewable raw materials.

Keeping the Nolla cabin clean

It is very important that you leave the cabin tidy for the next customer. Please wash all dishes well, sweep the floor, dust quilts and bedding. Also leave the shelf and hob clean.

Please let us know about any broken, lost or dirty items. It is very important to us that the cabin stays clean and well maintained. Please do not leave behind anything that you brought with you, and if you notice anything in the cabin or the surrounding nature that does not belong there, please help us and the environment by taking such objects with you. Grilling

Visitors at the Nolla cabin have access to a Big Green Egg grill, which is very easy to use. Choose the temperature by adjusting the air vents at the bottom and top of the grill. You can fill the charcoal up to the upper edge of the bottom part. Do not use too much charcoal so that the temperature does not get too hot. Charcoal can be found in the sauna building, in a closet in the women's locker room, just to the left of the door.

Water point

In Isosaari, there is a water point on the south side of the sauna building on the outside wall. The waterpoint is marked with a sign: Vesipiste. The water is drinkable. You can also wash dishes here.

Toilet and shower facilities

Toilets and showers can be found in the sauna building. There are also two other toilets located on the premises of Restaurant Upseerikerho close to the harbour.

Sauna

The entrance to the Nolla sauna is located on the harbor side of the sauna building, opposite the swimming dock. You must wear a swimsuit in the sauna. The sauna is heated by the island host and available at the following times:

- Women from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m.
- Men from 7 p.m. to 8 p.m.
- Mixed from 8 p.m. to 9 p.m.

Personnel

Please note that Isosaari is not staffed at all times.

How to get to Isosaari

The transport to Isosaari departs from Lyypekinlaituri next to the Market Hall. When there is scheduled ferry service, you can get to Isosaari with any M/S Viapori ferry. On other days, the water taxi M/S Taxen to Isosaari leaves from the same place at 11.45 a.m. and returns to the mainland from Isosaari harbour at 10.45 a.m. Please remember to reserve enough time at the harbour (about 15 minutes).
